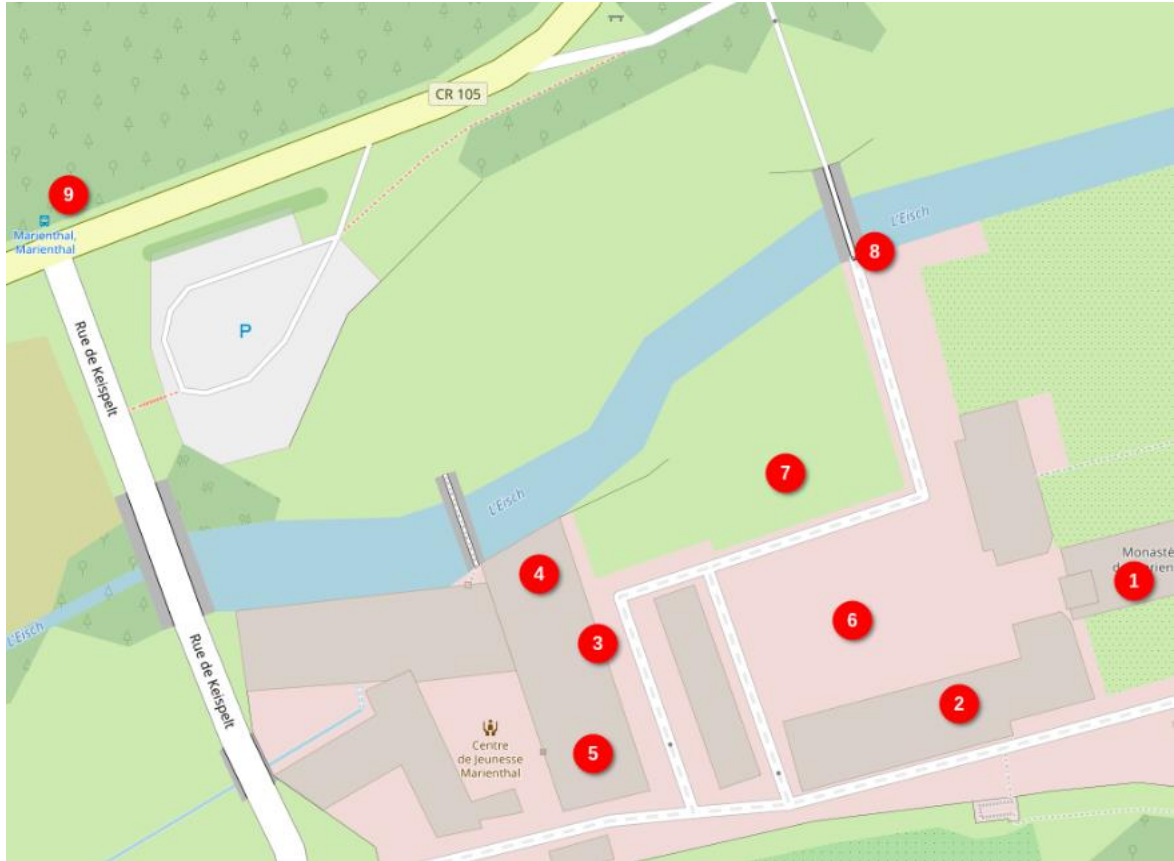

We will shed light on typical conflict themes and dynamics that arise in self-organized group contexts. Participants will learn a variety of approaches and strategies for addressing conflicts within groups and will have the opportunity to put these techniques into practice through interactive role-playing exercises.
